



ShipMoney actively supports a greener transition of the shipping sector to a sustainable future. Led by Rupert Fee, ShipMoney recently collaborated with Plastic Bank to stop ocean plastic and improve lives in vulnerable coastal communities.

Plastic Bank[®] is a social enterprise committed to stop ocean bound plastic and alleviate global poverty at the same time. To do this, Plastic Bank is building ethical recycling ecosystems in impoverished coastal communities. Our collectors receive a premium for the materials they collect to help them provide basic family necessities such as groceries, school tuition and health insurance. The collected plastic waste is reborn as Social Plastic[®], which is reintegrated into products and packaging. This creates a regenerative supply chain while helping those who collect it. CHALLENGE

Established in 1984, V.Ships is a global ship management company that offers technical services, risk management, procurement and financial services for the tanker, bulker, container, offshore and



SOLUTION

Within three weeks, ShipMoney set up a complex account and sub-account structure with reporting for several hundred ships. In addition, we created multiple user admin roles, established tokenization credentials and trained

leisure sectors.

When an armed conflict broke out and sanctions were levied, thousands of crew members faced a crisis. They couldn't access their money, use bank cards or accept wages to their home bank. shoreside staff in several countries.

ShipMoney issued more than 4,000 virtual debit cards to affected crew members around the world, which allowed V.Ships to meet the March payroll on time. Soon after, we arranged for delivery of physical debit cards to each ship carrying affected crew members.

RESULTS

Crew members were relieved to receive their wages, access their assets and send money to family members while onboard. Card funding has increased more than 300% between March and April, and affected crew members quickly adapted to using ShipMoney cards to accept wages, pay bills and provide family members with access to cash. This relatively new effort continues to be adopted and expanded across the V.Ships fleet worldwide.
